It is almost time to start the RE year! Of course you are welcome to register at any time by seeing me, or the office. I will be at all of the Masses on the weekend of 26 August 2018. It is important for the student to be registered as early as possible. First day of class is 16 September.

Parents are the first, and by far, the best teachers of the Faith to their children! The most important thing we can teach is that we must attend Mass every Sunday, and holy day of obligations (Canon 1247: On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass...). If we have to work, and it is impossible to attend Mass on Sunday, it is excused. However; Mass with Religious Education is best. RE is offered twice on Sundays of the school year. These occur at 10:15 a.m., and 5:45 p.m., this is perfect timing to allow your child, and you to attend Mass! If, by chance, you cannot attend, please see me to sign a permission slip that allows them to attend Mass, and then you pick them up after.
