Catechetical Sunday will be celebrated on 17 September 2017 at the 11:30 Mass. All Religious Education (RE) teachers are asked to attend. This is a thanks giving for all RE volunteers, and a special blessing as we start the new year.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (CCD) REGISTRATION NEWS:

The primary purpose of our Religious Education Program is faith formation. Faith formation is an ongoing development of the whole person into the image and likeness of Jesus Christ, Discipleship. To use the image of St. Paul "we put on Christ" so that Christ is the center of our lives. The second purpose of our Religious Education Program is sacramental preparation.

RE is offered from Kindergarten to Twelfth grade on a weekly basis. Classes are offered Sundays @ 10:15 a.m. and again @ 5:45 p.m. Keep your eye on the new Religious Education News part of our Sunday Bulletin for more information.

First Holy Communion: Students must attend RE classes for TWO YEARS in order to receive

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: Formation for the Sacrament begins in the 1st grade, and the Sacrament is made in the 2nd grade.

FIRST RECONCILIATION: (Confession): Students are instructed in the Sacrament of Penance before First Holy Communion; and are given the opportunity to go to First Confession several months BEFORE FIRST HOLY COMMUNION.

CONFIRMATION: According to Diocesan norms, students must be in the ELEVENTH OR TWELVE GRADE to be considered for the sacrament of Confirmation. The students must also possess knowledge of the faith. Formation begins in the 9th grade

CHILD PROTECTION RETRAINING: The new training year for Child Protection began August 1st. All religious, employees, and volunteers with substantial contact with minors must complete their annual retraining by October 31st.

BURSE CLUB SECOND COLLECTION: *The second collection this week will be for the Priests Burse Club. The Burse Club is an effort that supports seminarian education and dues are only \$12.00 per year (no meetings for this club and no time commitments!). Registered members of the parish should have received an envelope from the Archdiocese – please, if you have not mailed your contribution, put your envelope in the second collection. The Archdiocese Office of Vocations and the ACCW (Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women) are working together to support seminarian education; seminarian education costs are about \$50,000.00 per seminarian annually.
